Tours

You must pre-register (form on back side of convention registration form) to participate in the driving tours. All the tours have descriptions, vehicle requirements and physical demands to help you plan the best trip for you.

All tours depart from Fort Douglas. Plan to leave at 8:30 am

Pony Express Driving Tour – Tour Guide David Jabusch

Total Time 5 hours round trip

Depart from Fort Douglas - dirt roads, regular clearance vehicle, minimal walking

First stop approx. 45 minutes driving time to "Old Mill museum <http://www.bensonmill.org/> and Pioneer Museum <http://www.tooelepioneermuseum.org/> in Tooele. See Wright Homestead artifacts.

Pony Express Turnoff – Rush Valley - Stopping at Wright Homestead and Faust Station

Camp Floyd – Transit, Tour of Camp Floyd (time for lunch)

Rockwell Station – Transit

Stansbury Rock Art Tour – Tour Guide -Troy Scotter and Steve Manning (URARA)

Total Time 4 hours round trip

Depart from Fort Douglas - dirt roads, regular clearance vehicle, hike of about a mile to the sites with some minor scrambling up gentle slopes to see majority of panels. Most of the panels are abstract with some representational elements. The time frame probably ranges from the archaic to early Fremont.

Danger and Juke Box Cave Tour - Tour Guide Ron Rood

Time 6 hours round trip

Depart from Fort Douglas - dirt roads, regular clearance vehicle, hike to Danger Cave is a short distance, up hill, must climb down wooden ladder to get into cave. Hike to Juke Box cave has a steep rock/gravel with uneven footing. We will visit Danger Cave first to allow those who do not feel they can make the hike to Juke Box.

How to Find your way to the Fort Douglas Museum

From Downtown –

Find your way to State Street and 400 South, head east approx. 2.9 miles the road will curve. You will pass Rice/Eccles Stadium and Olympic Park on your left.

Turn Left onto MARIO CAPECCHI DR approx 0.4 miles. It is the next main intersection with a left turn signal light after Guardmans Way. Look for signs showing where to turn for Fort Douglas

Turn RIGHT onto Hempstead Road (the sign at the light has South Campus Drive which is the name of the road on the westside. Approx 0.1 miles. There are signs showing where to turn for Fort Douglas

Turn LEFT onto CHASE ST. approx 0.1 miles

Turn RIGHT onto POTTER ST .approx 0.1 miles.

From I-80 and 215

Take the Foothill Drive Exit and continue for approx. 3 miles

Turn RIGHT onto MARIO CAPECCHI DR approx 0.4 miles. Look for signs showing where to turn for Fort Douglas

Turn RIGHT onto Hempstead Road (the sign at the light has South Campus Drive which is the name of the road on the westside. Approx 0.1 miles.

Turn LEFT onto CHASE ST. approx 0.1 miles

Turn RIGHT onto POTTER ST approx 0.1 miles.

Parking

There is a parking lot to the west of the museum. Please park here so you don't get a ticket
